


Newspaper Log Roller
Recycle newspapers into fuel



Our newspaper log roller will give you a way to use up those old newspapers in a useful and constructive manner. Tightly wrapped newspaper burns slowly and provides extended periods of heat. Insert folded edge of paper into slot and start winding. Once started, keep adding sections of newspaper until log is desired size (3/4" OD maximum). With practice a log can be rolled in about 5 minutes. Pull center rod out of log to remove. Attractive bronze and black painted cast alloy and sheet metal, wood handle. 23"Lx7 1/2" Wx13"H, 8 lb. imported. **#72-737**; \$37.95

Note: Paper logs should not be used in a catalytic stove as the smoke may damage the catalyst.


